She has won creative grants from the Colombian National University and has exhibited in domestic and international galleries and museums.

She is interested in the construction of image and the way that artistic practices, such as photography, are catalysts of cultural investigation processes and give back a self-image to communities. She is interested in the gestural narrative of everyday life as emphasised by sensitive knowledge. She aims to highlight how Intangible Cultural Heritage contributes real social temporality to smallholders.

- She is consolidating a new project "The Alejandria Wheat Mill, activating and safeguarding a fragment" Gachantivá, Alto Ricaurte-Boyacá. The development of a Rural regional center of culture, practices and crafts is proposed in this rural area, where the inhabitants are invited to recognize themselves in their knowledge and practices, giving continuity to the Safeguarding of Intangible Cultural Heritage in the region.
- She is working on organizing a visual and audio narrative archive derived from the rural experiences developed around ICH. This archive will become an itinerant exhibition presented to the National Bank Library in Tunja, Boyacá and to the Taller de Boyacá School, with a view to travelling in 2020.
